PREFACE

Spreading Legal Literacy and Awareness among the masses, particularly, socially and economically underprivileged is one of the foremost objectives of Legal Services Authorities. The Tamil Nadu State Legal Services Authority is doing a commendable work by releasing "booklets" on various enactments. The present booklet is on "The Hindu Minority and Guardianship Act, 1956".
